YSC Face 2 Face (F2F) networks are local support and networking groups for young women affected by breast cancer. When a young woman is diagnosed with breast cancer, one of the overwhelming emotions is isolation and loneliness.

They often don't know any women their age who are also facing a breast cancer diagnosis. YSC F2Fs bring young women together so they don't feel alone. They can connect with other women like them to share stories, experiences and support.
